CRITERIA TO SELECT POTENTIAL STUDENTS FOR PROFESSIONAL HUNTING TRAINING FOR PDIs IN GAUTENG PROVINCE

The following is the list of requirements for a person to be considered for the proposed training:-

| No | Requirement | Rationale |
|----|--|---|
| 1 | Permanent residence in Gauteng Province | This is a Provincial initiative to empower people in the Province. |
| 2 | 21 years old and above | This is a legal requirement in terms of Ordinance 12 of 1983. |
| 3 | Must be South African citizen | This is to empower SA citizens to alleviate poverty levels. |
| 4 | At least have a matric certificate or equivalent. Any qualification in Biodiversity Management will be an added advantage. | The incumbent must be able to read and understand contracts with overseas clients. The course content also requires some level of literacy. |

| 5 | Driver's license is essential | After completing the course, the incumbent will be expected to drive an overseas client within the country. |
| 6 | Speak English | Most hunting clients are English and the course is conducted in English |
| 7 | Must be physically fit | Hunting involves a lot of walking and mountain climbing during tracking of wounded animals. |
| 8 | Must have no criminal record | Accountability and credibility are essential as this involves foreign clients. |
| 9 | Must be between 21 and 35 years old. | The program is targeted to the youth. |
| 10 | Must have some experience in hunting or related activities such as tracking and skinning. | The PH training is for people who have some experience in hunting. |
